

## REDFYRE TRADITIONAL HEAT STORAGE COOKER

### YOUR TECHNICAL QUESTIONS ANSWERED

What types of fuel can be used to run the Traditional Cooker?

The Traditional can run on Natural Gas, LPG or Kerosene (normal domestic fuel oil).

What style of flue can be used with the Traditional Cooker?

A conventional flue only.

Does the cooker need to be situated against an external wall?

Not necessarily. This will be depend on the intended location and is best discussed on site with your dealer during the site survey.

Will the floor need reinforcing?

As long as the floor is not suspended there should be no reason to reinforce. However, your Redfyre dealer will confirm this when undertaking a site survey.

Can the Traditional Cooker supply domestic hot water?

Yes on all models, except the Gas 4 Oven.

Is the Traditional Cooker designed for intermittent use?

No, it is designed for constant use and, due to its heat storage capabilities is still economical. It will also generate about 1kW of background heat, giving the kitchen a warm, cosy atmosphere.

How often should my Traditional Cooker be serviced?

The gas version should be serviced annually whilst the oil version should be every six months.

*N.B. Please note it is imperative that your dealer performs a site survey prior to installation. Failure to do so will almost certainly result in impaired long-term performance.*
